

Another Pint's August Newsletter

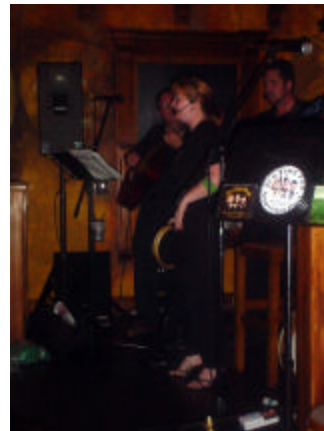
